



Extract from Manifesto:

Environment, Energy and Sustainable Development

According to the first World Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro, the five pillars of sustainable development were singled out, i.e.;

- Maintaining and increasing of output;
- Safeguarding resources;
- Restriction of risks (ex. Dumping of poisonous waste);
- Social acceptability; and
- Economic viability.

In agreement with this the FF Plus supports sustainable development as development that reveals a clear ecological consciousness. On the basis of this, small scale and local development, which concentrates on self provisioning, food security and quality of life, is regarded highly.

The FF Plus supports attempts to develop renewable energy resources and work against the current exceptionally high levels of dependency on fossil fuels.

The FF Plus will also act as a watch dog against greedy enterprises which exploit bureaucratic shortcomings and corruption in government institutions in order to start non-sustainable and environmentally damaging projects.
